Overview

UNDP's Regional programme on Anti-Corruption and Integrity in the Arab Countries (ACIAC) is organizing a training on "Innovations in Measuring and Preventing Corruption" in Tangier, Kingdom of Morocco, from 25 to 30 June 2019.
