

## National Task Force Meeting Corruption Risk Management in the Water Sector

### Tunis, Tunisia, 8 September 2022



# Programme

### Overview

In cooperation with the Ministry of Agriculture, Water Resources and Fisheries and the General Directorate of Governance and Prevention of Corruption in the Presidency of the Government of the Republic of Tunisia, the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) is organizing a National Task Force Meeting on Corruption Risk Management in the Water Sector, on 8 September 2022, in Tunis, within the framework of UNDP's regional project on Anti-Corruption and Integrity in the Arab Countries (ACIAC), which is implemented in partnership with the Korean International Cooperation Agency (KOICA). UNDP Anti-Corruption and Integrity specialists will provide technical assistance to the workforce through conducting a joint review of the progress made, and following up on the achieved results, and agreeing on the next steps to complete the first assessment of corruption risks in the water sector of Tunisia.

This work will contribute to accelerating progress towards achieving SDG 6, which recognizes that sustainably managing water goes beyond simply providing a safe water supply and sanitation (targets 6.1 and 6.2) and would address the broader water context such as water quality, wastewater management, water scarcity, efficient use and management of water resources and protection and restoration of water-related ecosystems. In this context, the governance of the water sector and its prevention from corruption risks is a main priority, especially since it is a vital component of the development of any country.

The technical meeting is organized based on the outputs of several joint activities, the most recent of which is a specialized training on Corruption Risks Management in the Water Sector, held in Hammamet on 2 - 4 June 2022. The mentioned activity enabled an in-depth training for the task force, which was formed by the minister of Agriculture, Water Resources and Fisheries and the institutions under its supervision and supported by representatives of the Presidency of the Government, to implement the relevant methodology. Following its formation, the national task force initiated the work by holding a series of meetings during which the scope of work was identified and the organizational and practical steps for applying the sectoral corruption risk management methodology were discussed.
