- E.procurement is a solution to assist combatting fraud and corruption and to reinforce public accountability
- Digitalization is the driver of the transformation by setting up an electronic public procurement system TUNEPS as a single centralized system.
- TUNEPS is a pillar of digital transformation in Tunisia: it aims to digitilize the major steps of public procurement lifecycle



### THE ROLE OF TUNEPS IN REDUCING CORRUPTION

#### The TUNisian on-line E-procurement System: Main features

- Increasing transparency in government procurement by eliminating a paper-based, bureaucratic system and turning it into a more efficient operation.
- The capacity to greatly reduce the cost and increase the accessibility of information
- Allowing transparency and accountability : Identification of users ( public purchasers and private sector) and their responsabilities, traçability of all users tasks.



#### **Standardising and establishing the automation of processes :**

Reduce the number of encounters between potential bidders and public officials  $\rightarrow$  limits the opportunities for corruption.

#### Increasing access to information :

The improved accessibility to key documents and information  $\rightarrow$  improve fairness, efficiency and competition

#### Increasing competition and avoiding collusion :

More transparency in public procurement processes may influence the level of competition in the market



#### Facilitating contract oversight :

It includes contract management solutions  $\rightarrow$  help to make information available to a wider number of public officials, oversight agencies and for the public at large  $\rightarrow$  It may provide disincentives for corrupt behaviour

#### Improving oversight and audit capabilities :

It allows the detection and prevention of corruption in public procurement (structured, stored and acessible data for investigation and analysis).
