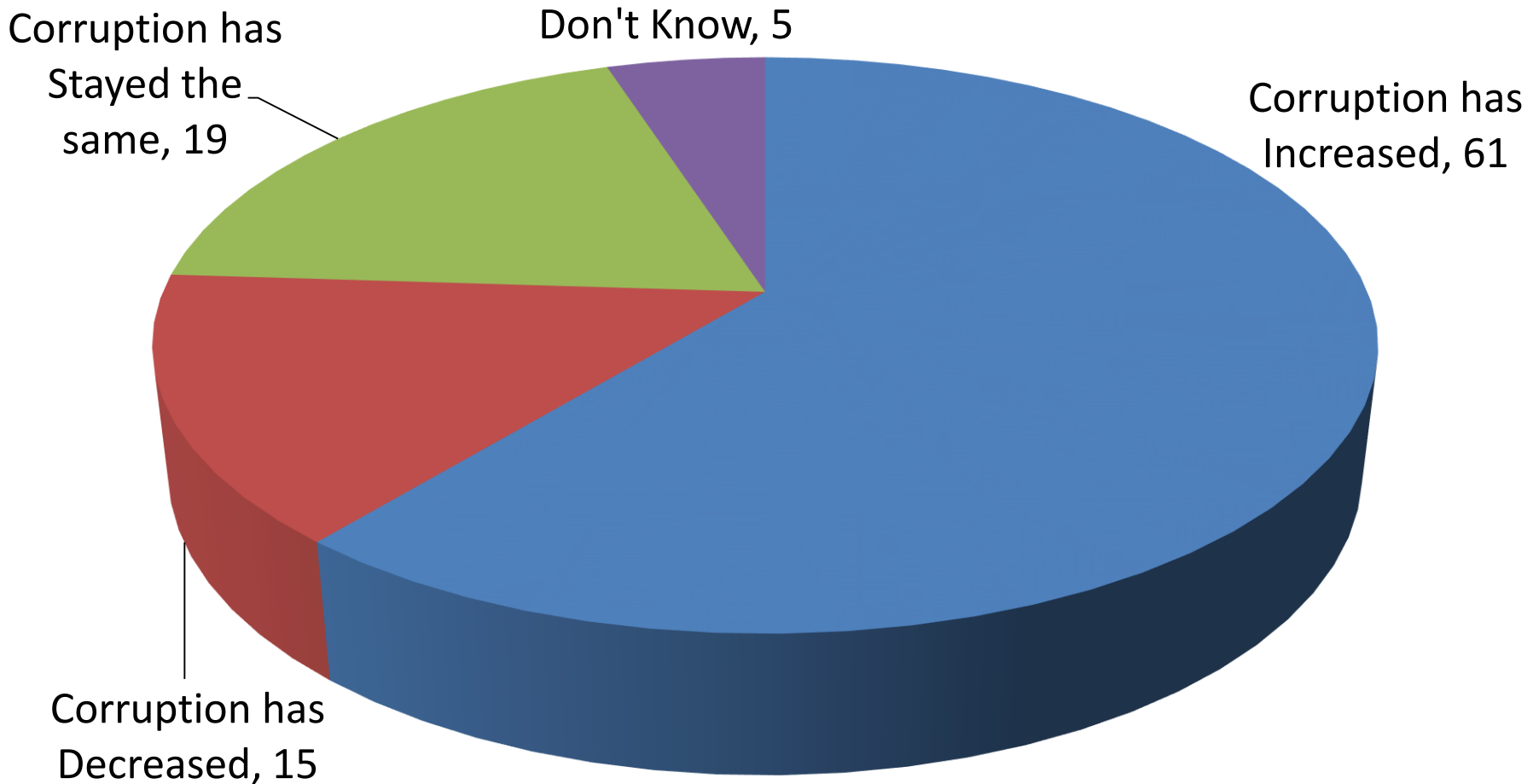

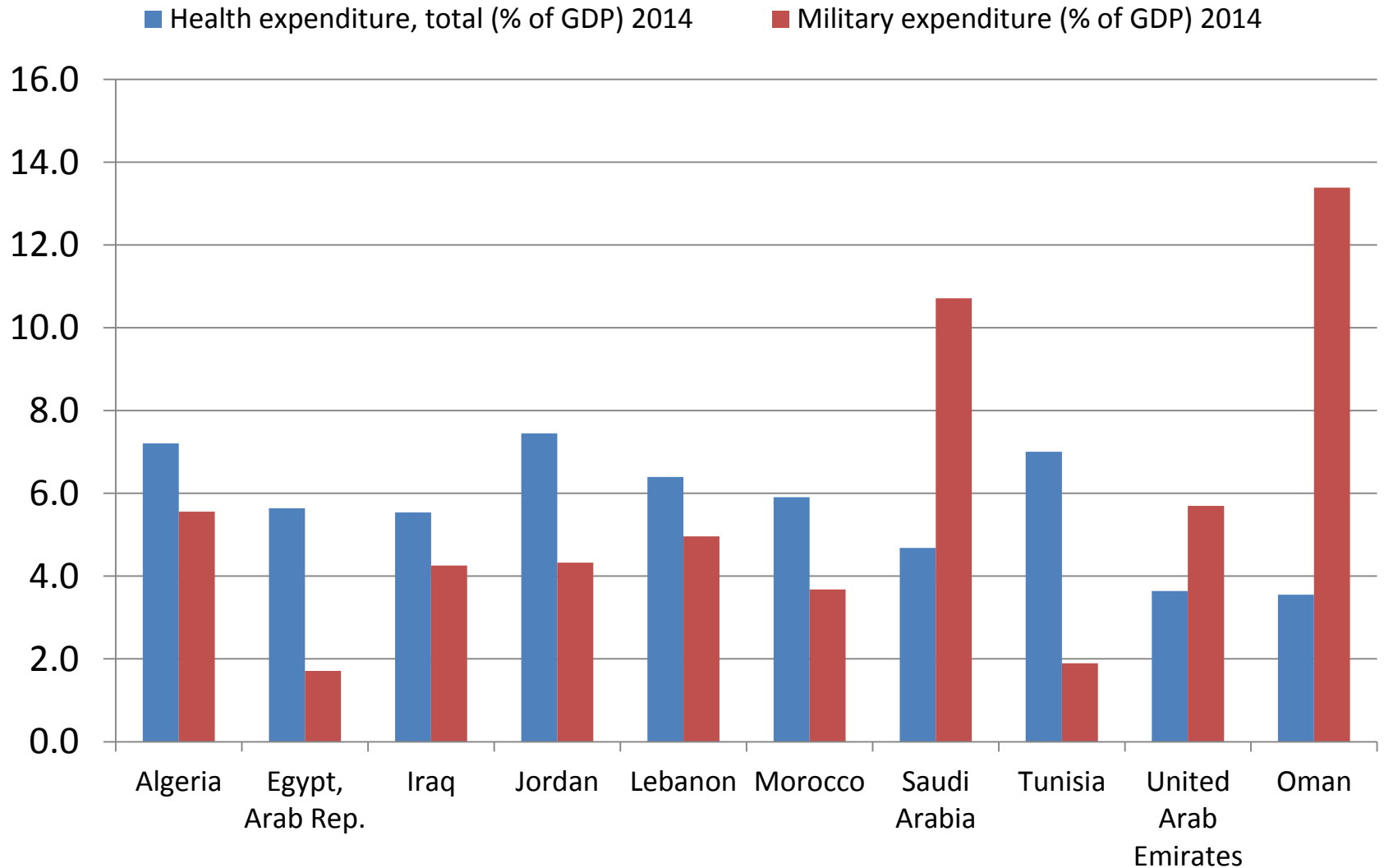

Is Corruption getting better or Worse? (%)



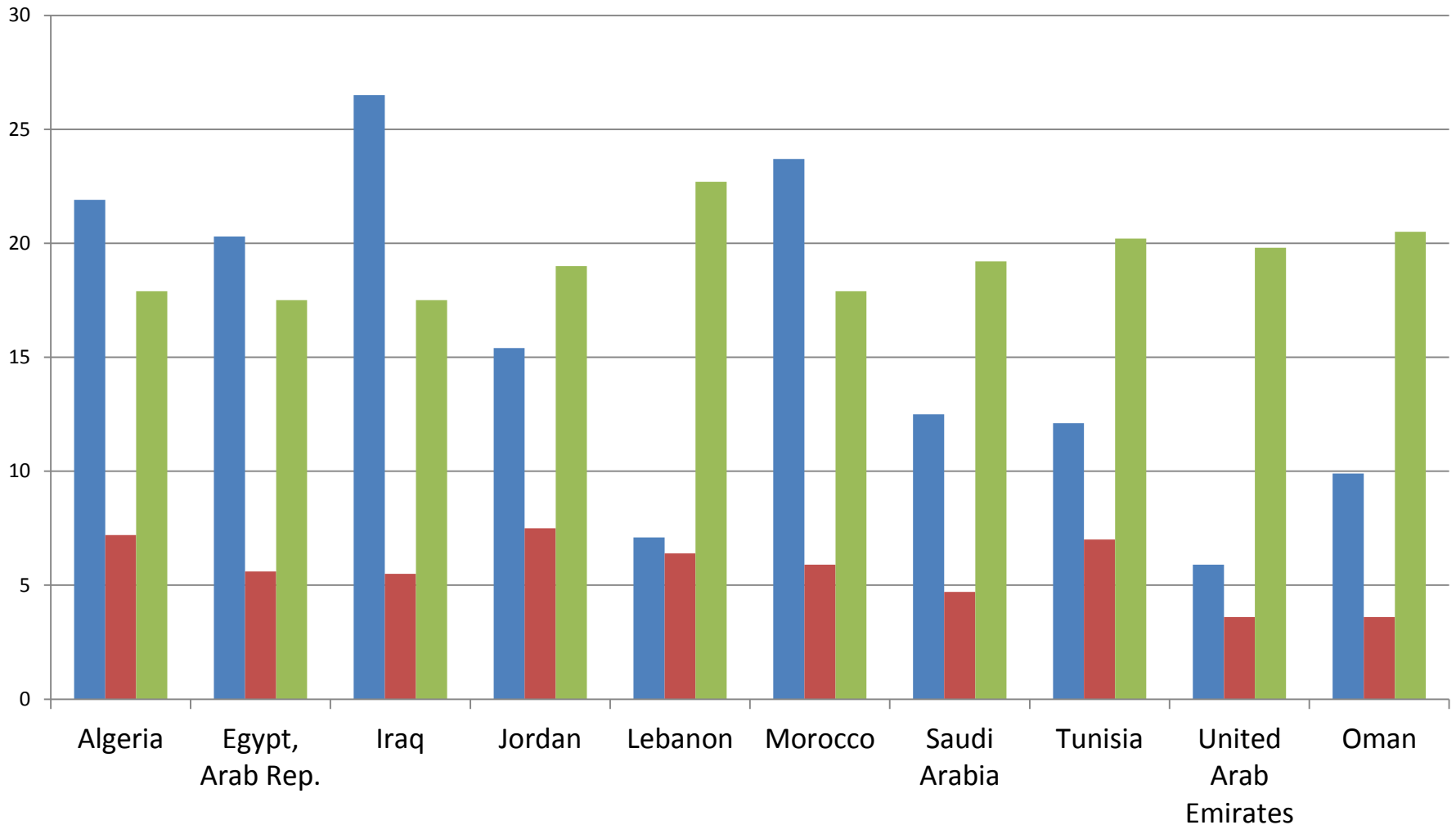


Total Health Expenditure As % of GDP Vs. Military Expenditure, 2014

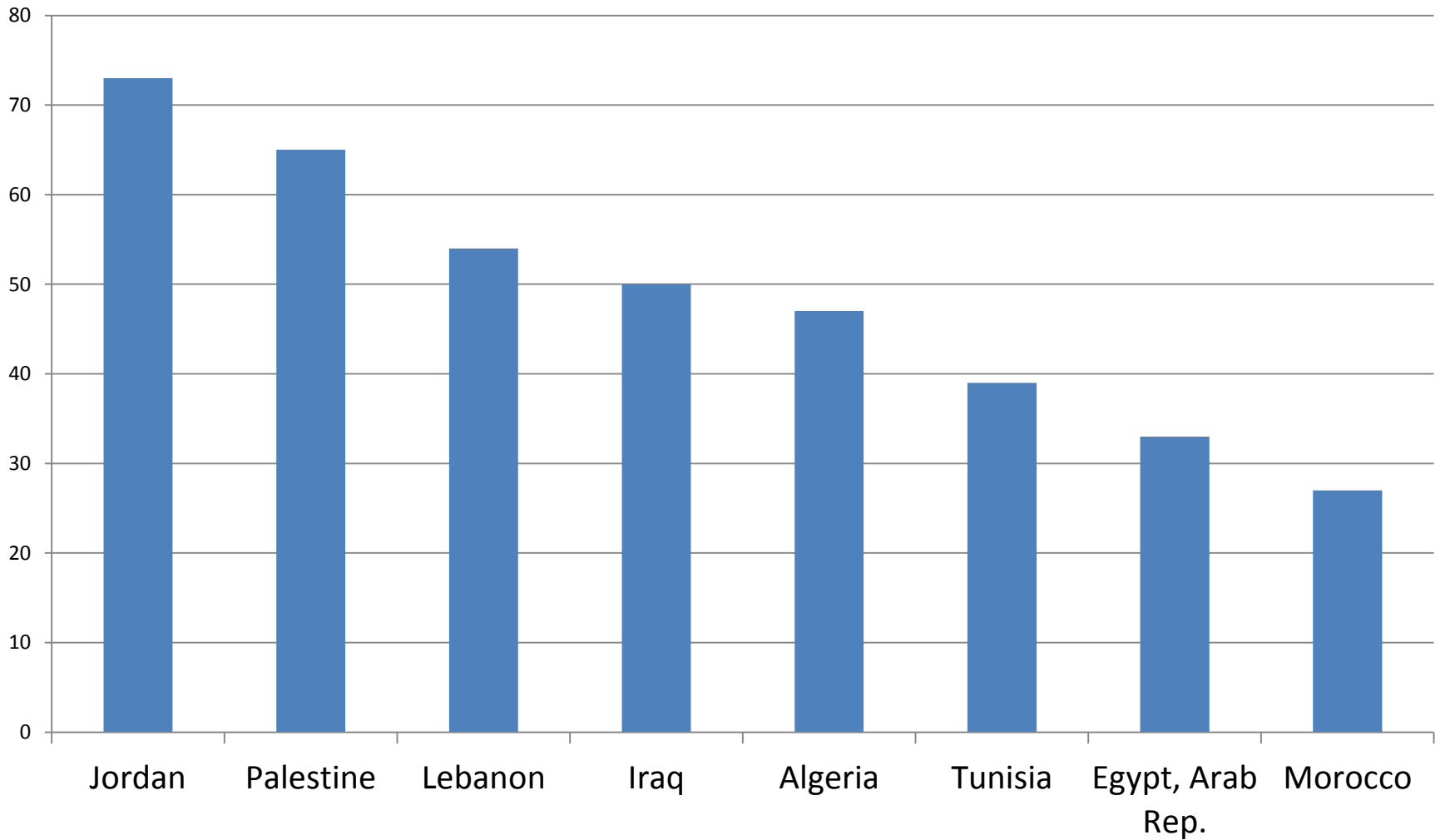

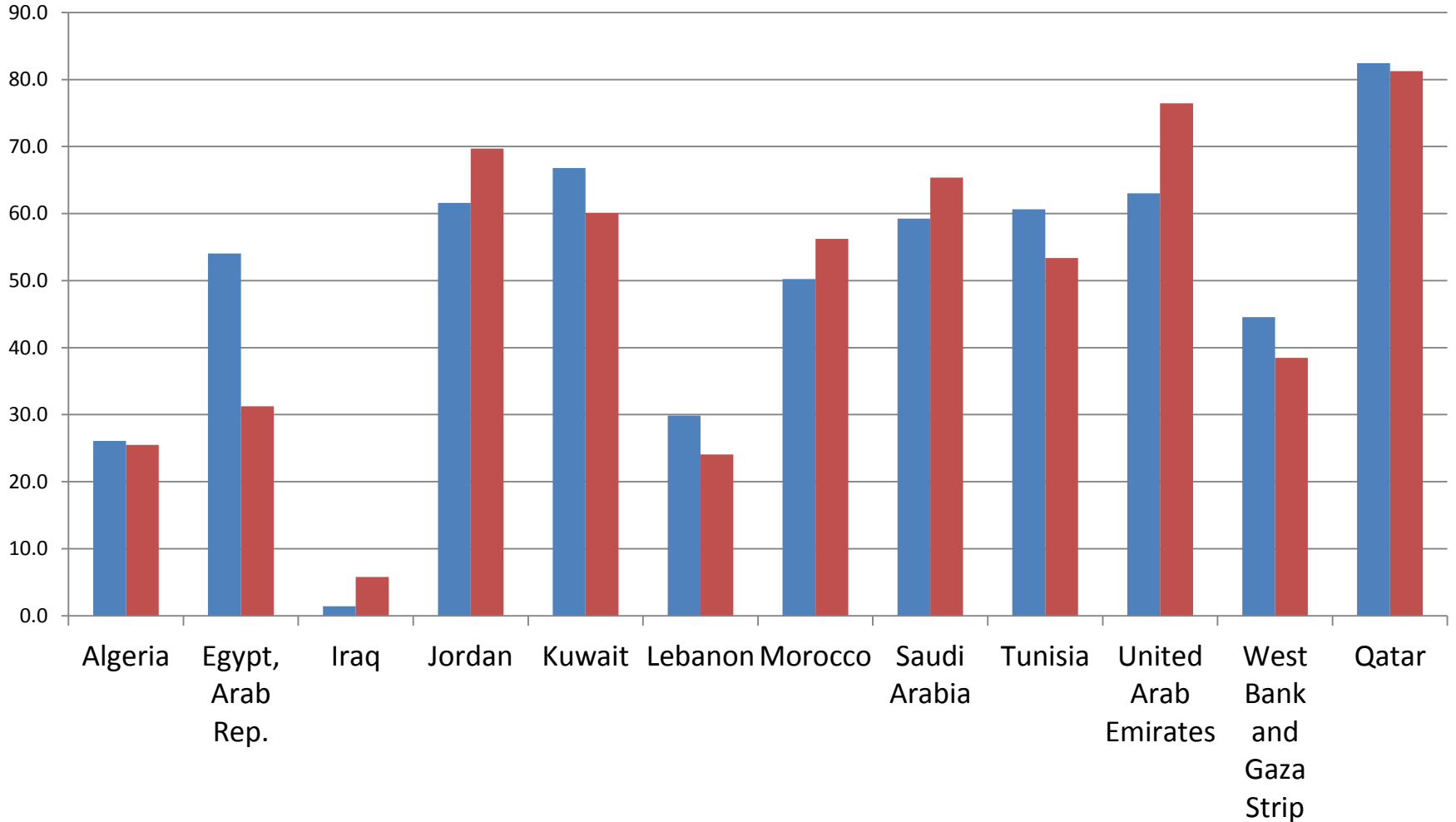

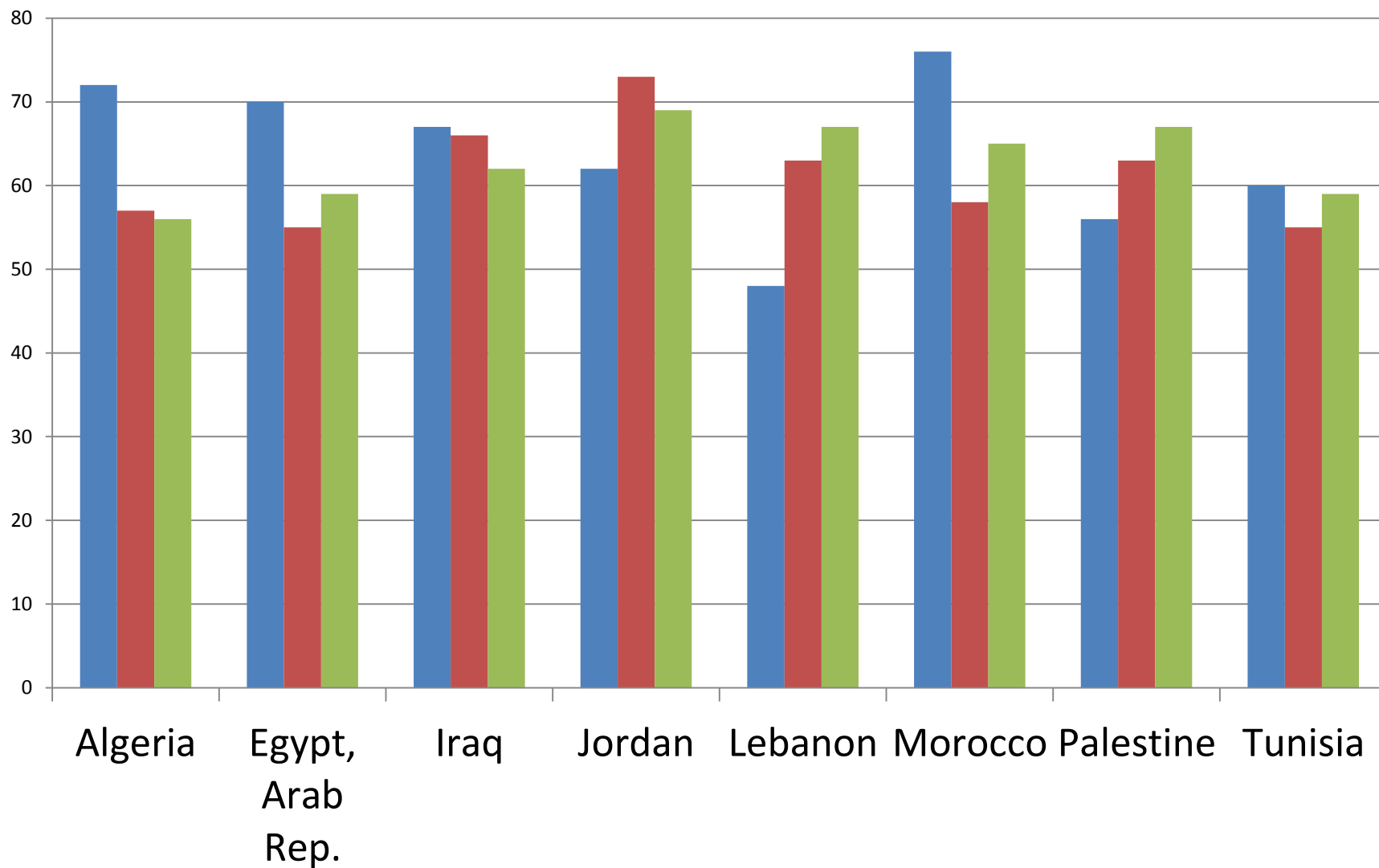

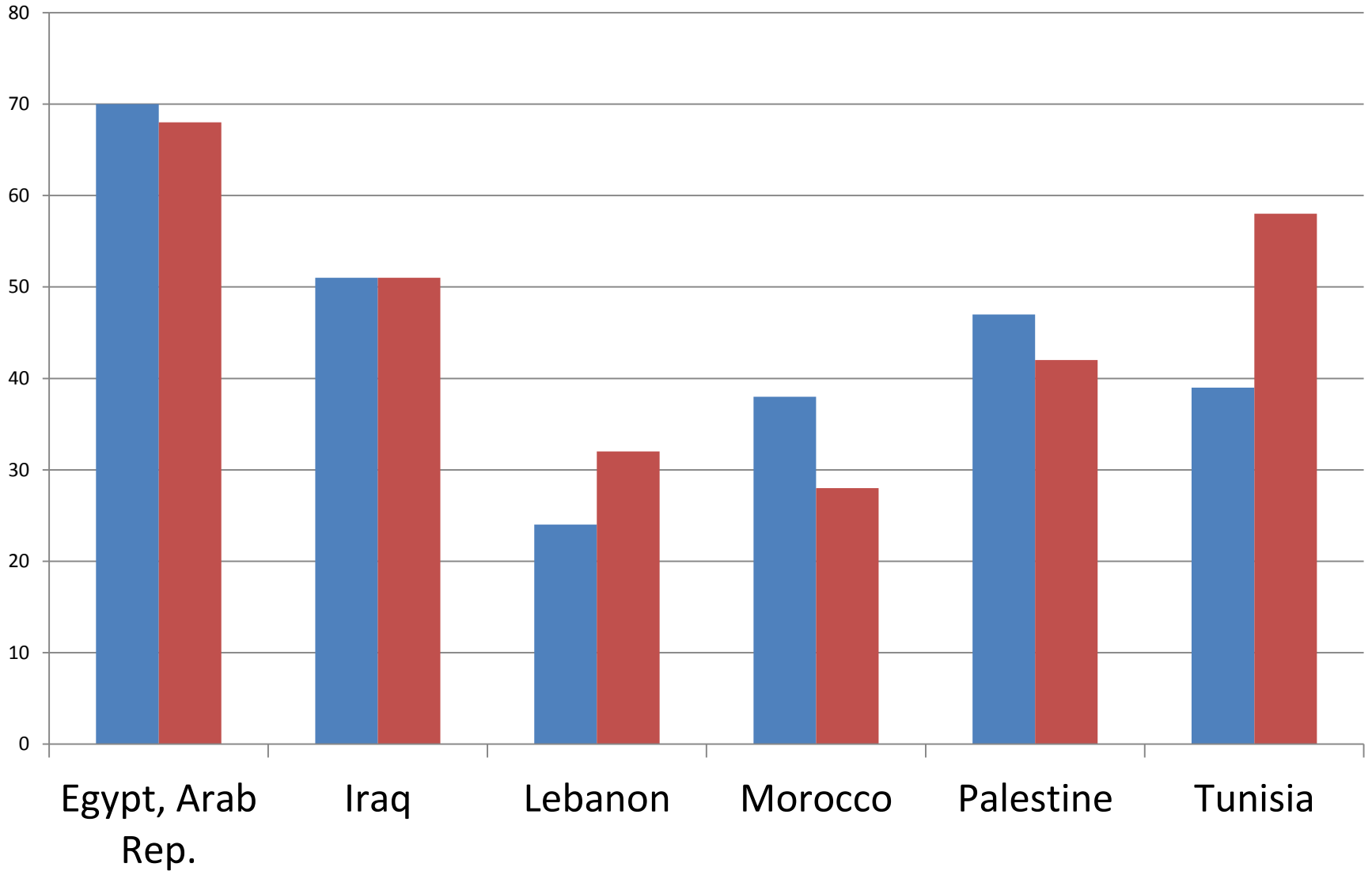

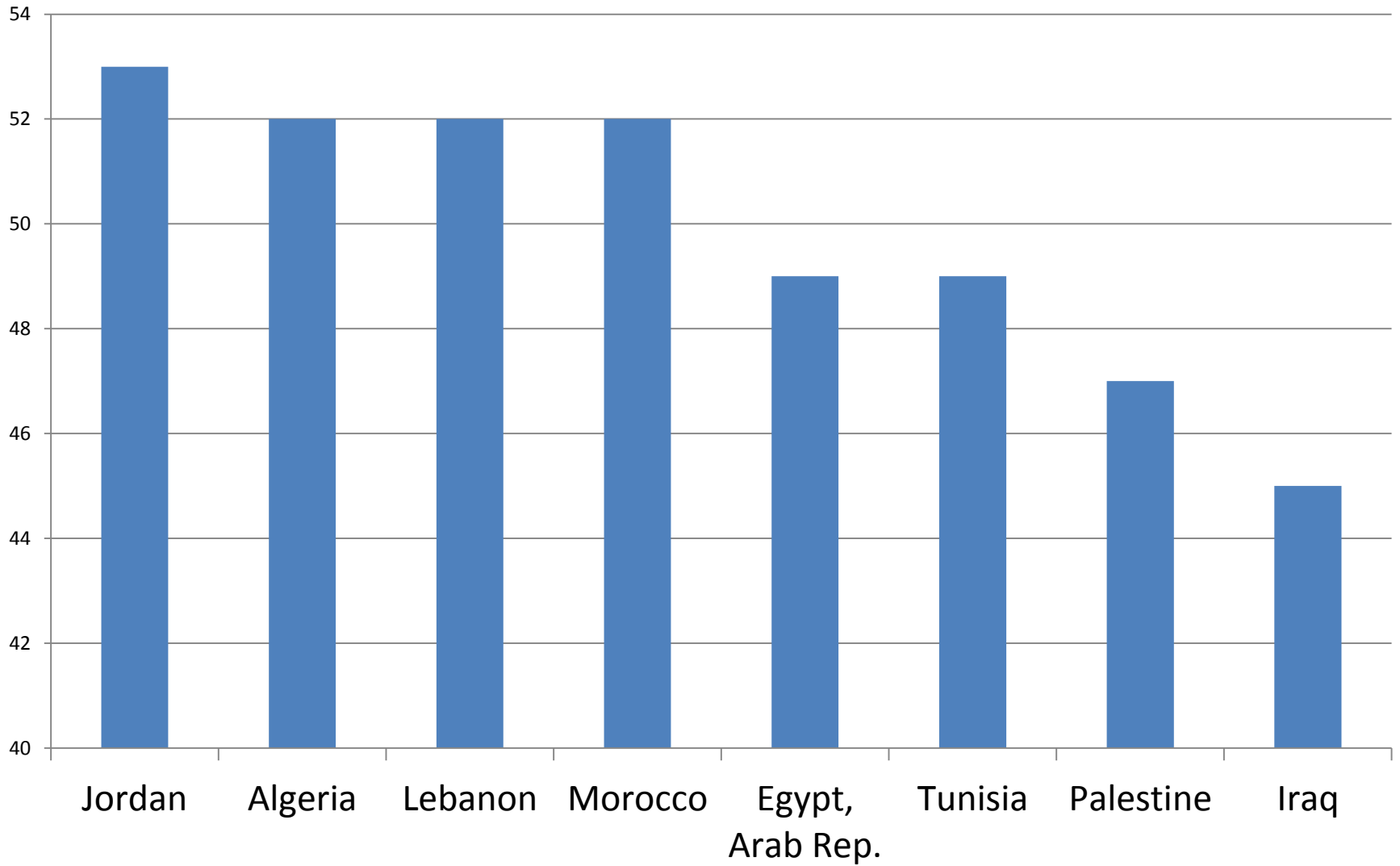

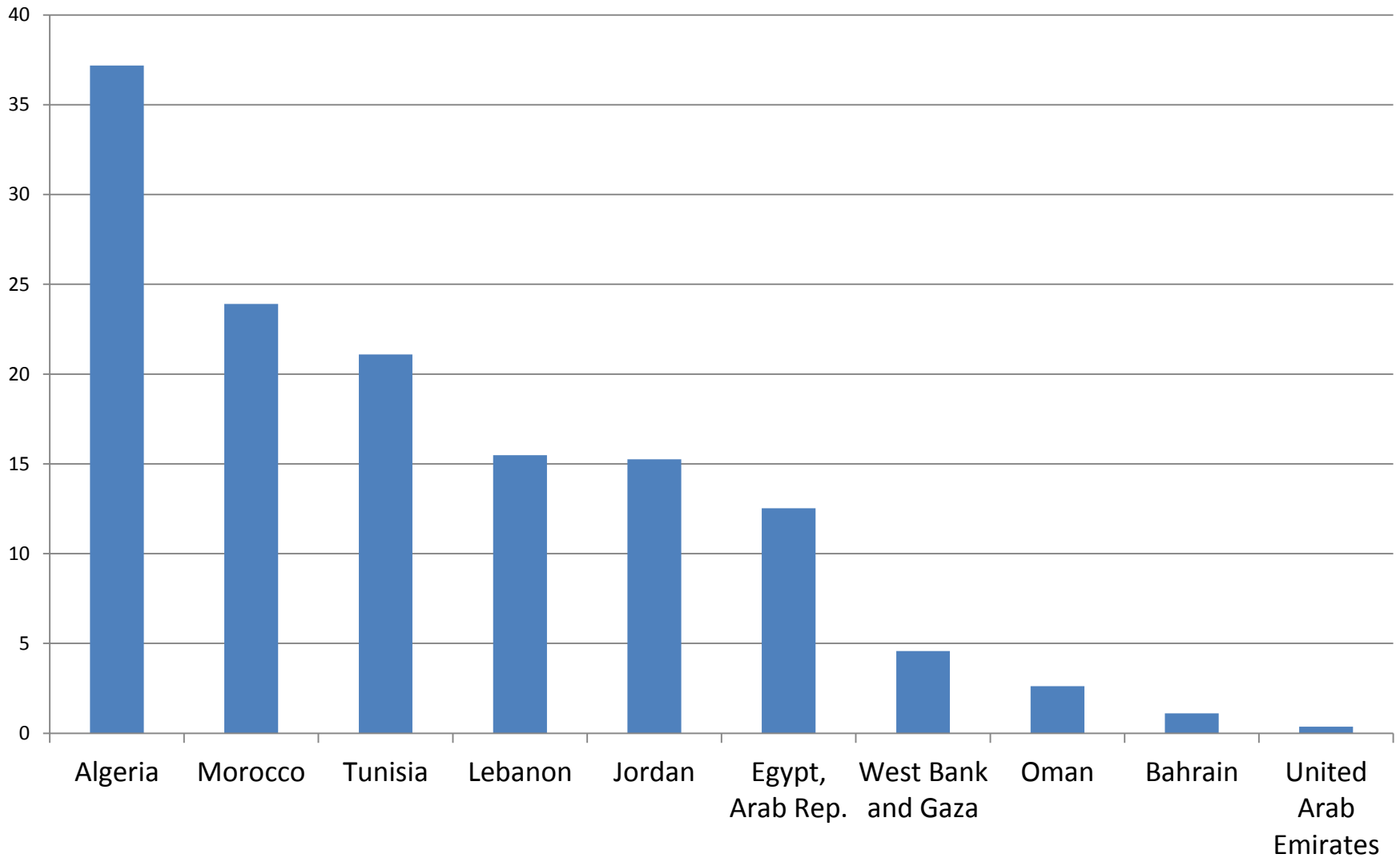

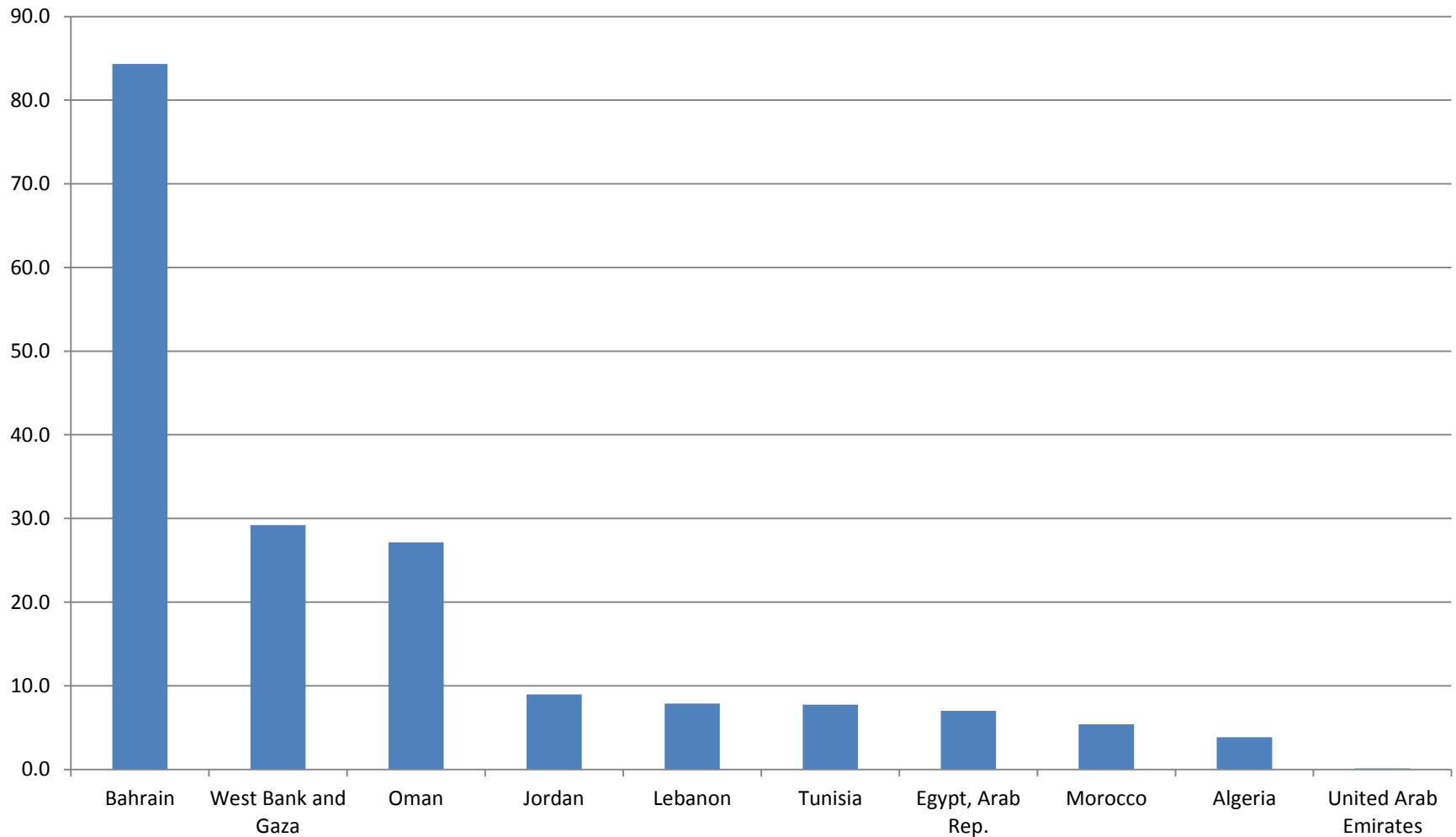

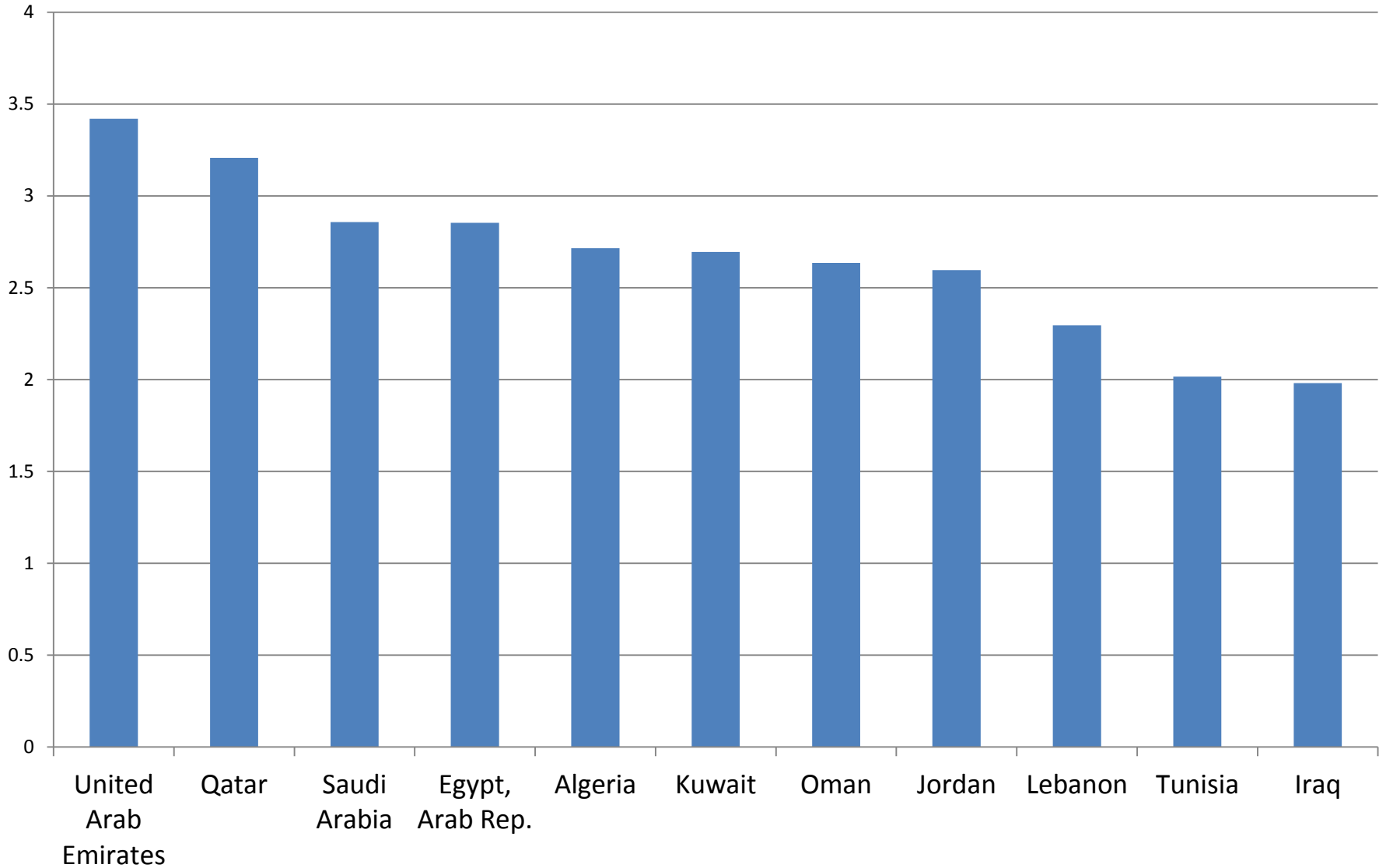
Tax revenue (% of GDP), 2012



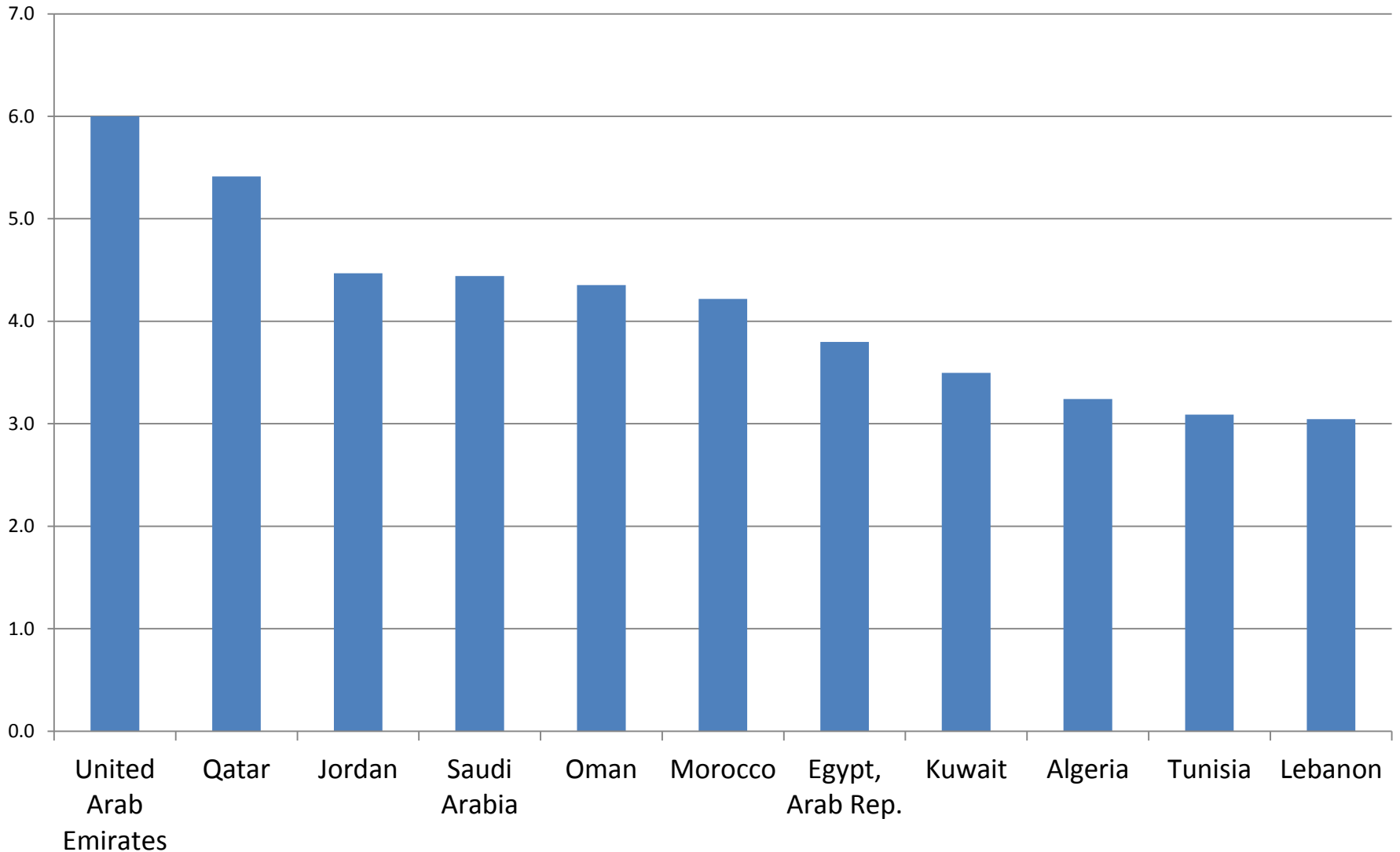
Customs and other import duties (% of tax revenue), 2011



Logistics performance index: Efficiency of customs clearance process (1=low to 5=high), 2014

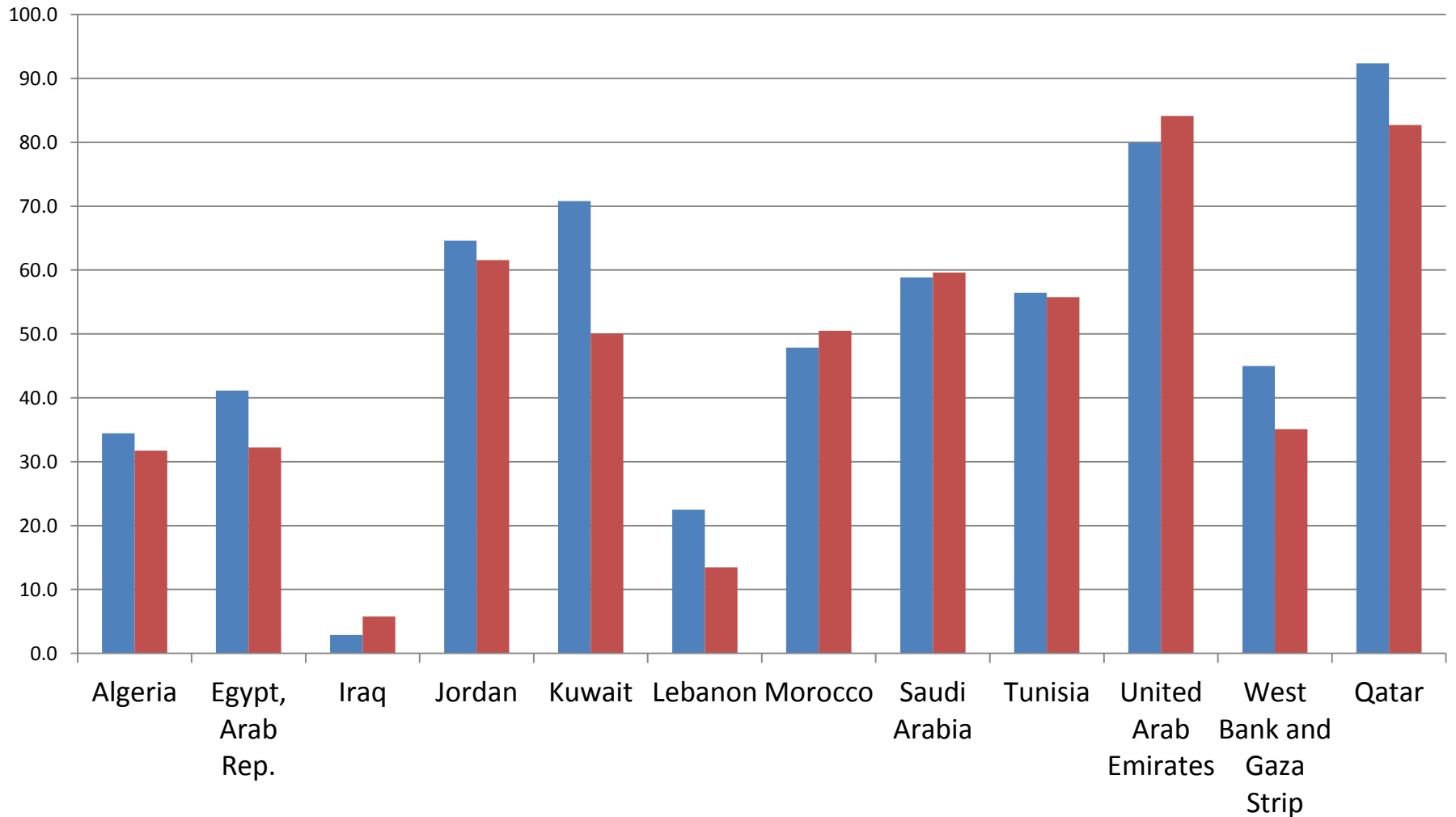


Burden of customs procedure, WEF (1=extremely inefficient to 7=extremely efficient), 2015

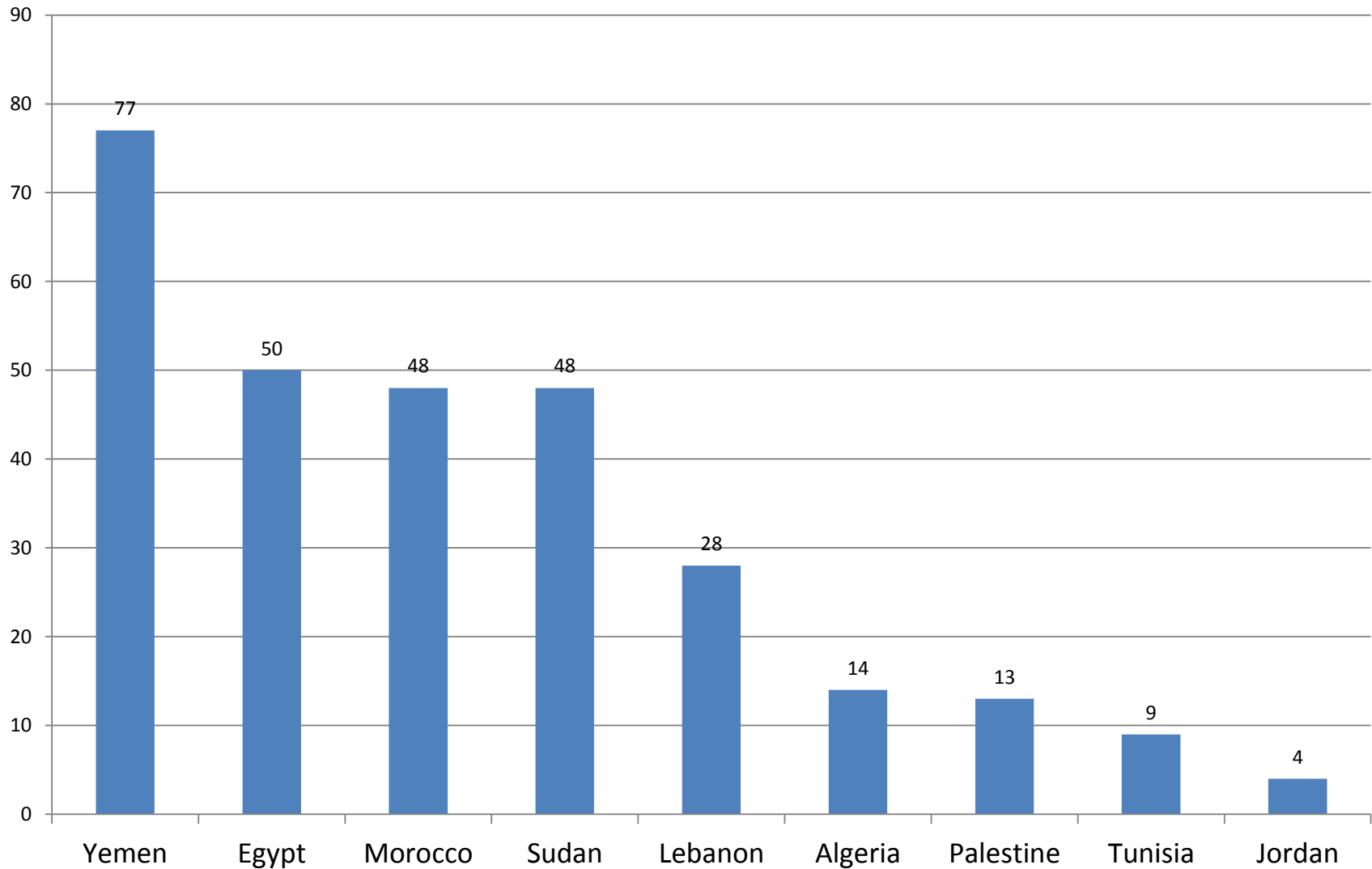

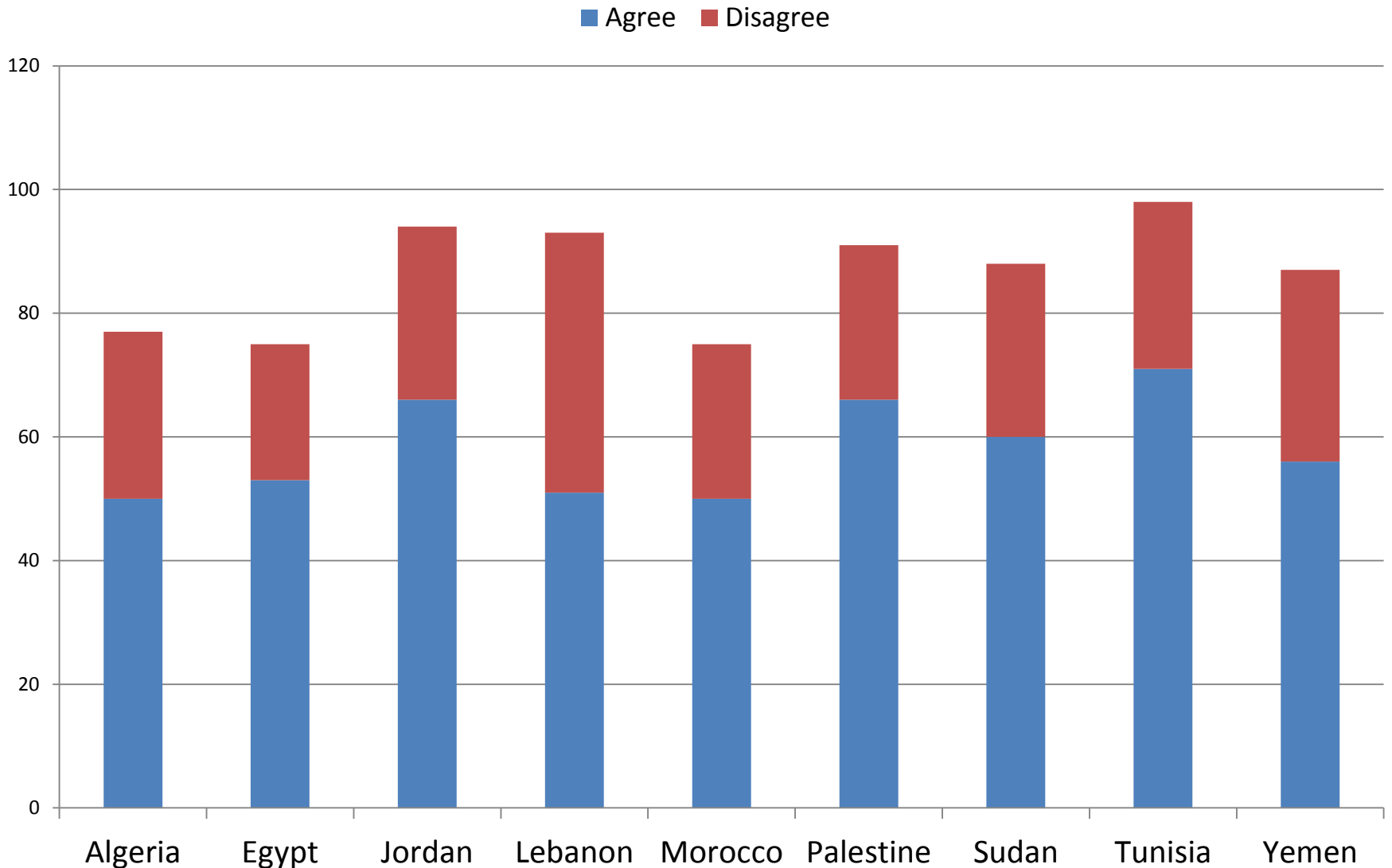

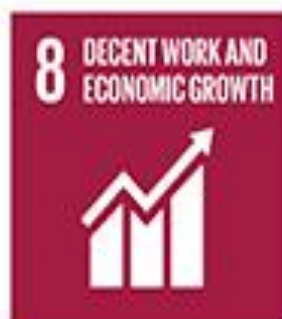
