## **Corruption Risk Management in Transport Sector**

Hammamet, Tunisia 09 – 11 June 2023



# Programme

#### Overview

In cooperation with the Ministry of Transport in Tunisia and the General Administration for Governance and Corruption Prevention at the Presidency of the Government, UNDP organized the second specialized training session on "Managing Corruption Risks in the Transportation sector" in Hammamet from 9-11 June 2023, in the framework of its regional project on Anti-Corruption and Integrity in Arab Countries implemented in partnership with the Korea International Cooperation Agency (KOICA).

The aim of this training is to strengthen the capacities of the sectoral task team formed by the Minister of Transport and previously trained by UNDP experts in a previous training session in June 2022. The second training provides an opportunity for a joint review of interim results achieved in assessing corruption risks in the sector up to the current date. This was achieved through a series of technical sessions and practical exercises necessary to reinforce detailed knowledge and specialized skills among the members of the sectoral team. The training also provided necessary technical guidance to design an appropriate plan to reduce the identified corruption risks and explore the importance of developing a suitable communication plan to align with the activities conducted by the team. The training concluded with a dedicated session on the next steps to support the upcoming phase.

The training is based on the outcomes of a cooperation track that includes several joint activities designed to align with the team's work and regular technical discussions. It began with a specialized session on "Corruption Risks in the Transport sector and ways to address them" on 9 March 2022, and followed by a national task force meeting "Corruption Risk Management in the Transport sector" on January 16, 2023.
